Sale Reports

Naracoorte Annual Shorthorn Bull Sale

With the Southeast of SA experiencing drier than normal conditions and the lack of confidence in the cattle market there was great value buying at the Naracoorte sale last week. 31 out of 46 bulls sold with an average of \$8355.

The top price of \$24, 000 was paid by Jasom and Kylie Catts, Futurity stud, Baradine NSW for an outstanding 23mth soft roan bull with exceptional data to match from the Brook's family, Eloora stud, Cavendish Victoria.

The second highest price of \$18, 000 was paid by Riverside Holdings Tintinara for a 23mth powerful rich red bull from the Pridham family, Nentoura stud at Frances.

For the first time, three sales were held in the same area over two days with a total of 116 bulls offered giving buyers more choice.



Bayview Shorthorn and Angus Annual On Property Bull Sale

Bayview Shorthorns and Angus held their third annual Sale on Wednesday 13th March, with great results across the board.

Lot 5, Bayview Daicos T50, turned plenty of heads but it was WA buyers Chris and Cheryl James, Stockdale Enterprises, Hyden, WA, who outlasted stiff competition to secure the \$18,000 sale topper from the Thompson family.

Daicos was by \$40,000 bull Futurity Quinella and out of Bayview Miss Betty M67.

Blackmoor Pastoral, Kingston SE, were the sale's volume buyer with four bulls including the second highest price, lot 19, Bayview Gladstone T57 which made \$16,000.

Overall 27 of 37 rising two-year-old Shorthorn bulls averaged \$9815.

Three specially selected PTIC heifers attracted strong competition to kick the sale off averaging \$8000.

All three were in calf to Gilman's All In 6K- a USSire which sold for US \$70,000.

Lot 1, Bayview Beverley T7, was knocked down for \$10,000 to GJ & JG Neve, Theresa Park, NSW.
